



Housing Connect Demographics

In May 2024, Housing Connect served 10,487 individuals from 4,921 households.

- 3,504 Housing Choice Vouchers
- **184** Public Housing Units
- 834 Locally Funded Housing Programs
- 900 Low-Income Housing Tax Credits Units


